To **set** (something) (somewhere): *se passer, se dérouler*

**his stories, set in the Paris of 1890,...** :

*ses histoires, qui se passent or qui se déroulent dans le Paris de 1890,...*

A **wizard** /'wɪzəd/: *magicien, enchanteur*

**disabled** /dɪs'eɪbld/: *handicapé*

**wheelchair** /'wi:lʃeə/: *un fauteuil roulant*

**fortunately** /'fɔ:tʃənɪtli/: *heureusement*

**a white lie**: *pieux mensonge*

To **take place**: *avoir lieu*

**What happened?** *Qu'est-ce qui s'est passé ?*

**carefully** /'keəfəli/: *soigneusement, attentivement, prudemment, avec précaution*

To **pass** an exam: *réussir (une épreuve)*

To **take** an exam: *passer (une épreuve)*

**unfortunately** /ʌn'fɔ:tʃənɪtli/ : *malheureusement*

**suddenly** /'sʌdnli/: *subitement, soudain, tout à coup*

**immediately** /ɪ'mi:diətli/: *immédiatement, tout de suite*

A **burglar** /'bɜ:glə/: *un cambrioleur*

**frightened** /'fraɪnd/: *effrayé*

To **turn** (something) off: *éteindre (qqc)*

A **spelling mistake**: *une faute d'orthographe*
